SAFE TRANSPORTATION and STORAGE OF LUNCHES

Weekday Ministries does not have a food service program, therefore students bring lunches from home. Weekday Ministries does not provide refrigeration for lunches. For this reason, we recommend that parents and guardians pack lunches that do not need to be maintained at a refrigerated temperature (e.g. no meat or dairy products).

If refrigerated foods are packed in the lunch, food must be brought to the facility in clean, insulated (with appropriate frozen packs), sanitizable containers, which keeps cold food at 41° F or below until it is eaten.

All food containers, regardless of need for refrigeration, must be clearly labeled with the child's name and date of preparation.
